Database Overview

In order to work with a database, a connection must be created. The parameters required for each type of database vary. A general overview is provided here, together with more specific instructions for commonly used databases.

Regular Expressions

Regular expressions are mostly used in the 'Text Filter Modifier/Engine' and 'Binary Filter Modifier', but it can also be very useful in JavaScript. A tutorial for regular expressions in provided here.

Lasernet 6.6 and older include symbologies for a list of linear barcodes. Barcodes, however, must be ordered separately as TrueType fonts from Elfring. Visit this link to know more.

Process Explorer

<u>Process Explorer</u> is an external application that used to monitor which handles and DLLs processes have opened or loaded. It can be useful for memory investigation or handling leaks in third-party drivers used by Lasernet.
